If you are too young to know what these things were, just remember, you are in your good old days right now. All of us should make the best of them for Christ no matter what age we are.

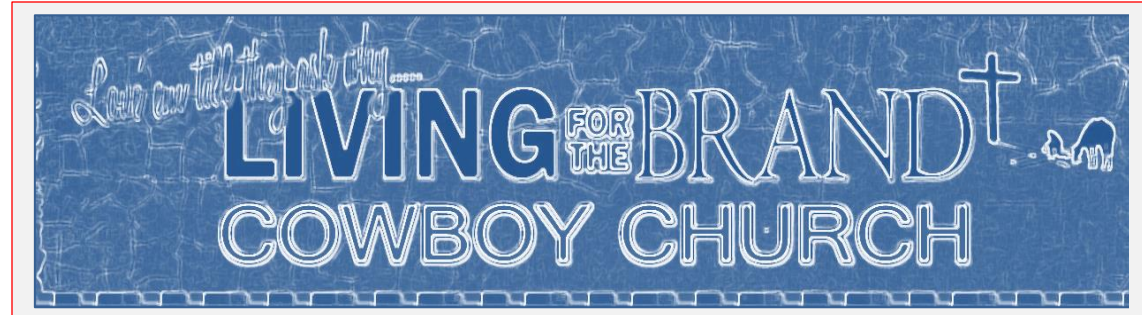
I love you and thank you for allowing me and Mitzi to serve at LFTBCC.

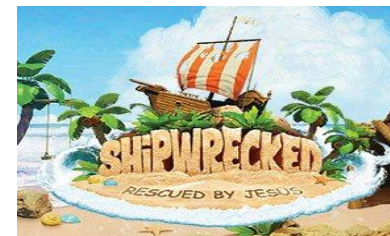
